

PUBLIC NOTICE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

WOOD RIVER MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE, NE3150301, Public Water Supply System in HALL County, is required by Nebraska's Regulations Governing Public Water Supplies, Title 179 NAC 3 to collect sample(s) quarterly for nitrates.

WOOD RIVER MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE Public Water Supply System is required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. For the quarterly period of October 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015 we did not monitor (or did not complete all the monitoring) for nitrates and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do? This is not an emergency and there is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

WOOD RIVER MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE Public Water Supply System regrets its failure to collect a valid nitrate sample and will work to ensure that the testing is observed in the future.
