Community Wildfire Protection Plan

. . . to prepare for and manage wildfire and improve
communication among agencies that respond to wildfire.

The plan, part of a statewide network of Community Wildfire
Protection Plans, provides readily-accessible information to
emergency responders from outside the area. It consolidates
and relays critical information needed for responders in
unfamiliar terrain. It is tailored by each county to include details
vital to protecting first responders, residents, and property.

Feedback from county residents may include topics such as:

- Ingress / egress routes and safe zones for citizens
- Structures and critical infrastructure (highways, cell towers, bridges, schools, etc.)
- Wildland urban interface areas such as homes or developments in high-risk areas
- Natural resources
- Identify high-risk ignition sources and safety guidelines

People may have concerns or suggestions in addition to these
typical CWPP priorities. All ideas are welcome. For further
